
### **Grant Updates**

Woodlands grant committee continues to forge ahead with plans to improve and preserve our theater. Big news this winter is that the Vinson Fund approved our request for lighted signage for the front of our building. We will now be able to more efficiently and professionally let you know about what is going on and upcoming performances.

We are also very excited to see our vision for the façade upgrade move one step closer to reality. Sean Taboloff turned our ideas for restoring the historic character of the building into a real image to work towards an initial architectural drawing of the front of the façade. With the help of knowledgeable volunteers

including our facilities chairman Andrew Urbaniak, and several professionals including Tom Bristol of Purple Flattop, Josh Carlen of Carlen Housewrights and Baldwin Sign in Spokane, we were able to come up with a budget for a second Community Strategies grant application to Inland NW Community Foundation. The request is for approximately half of the \$60,000 estimated cost. Woodland must still rely on our generous supporters and donors to make this dream a reality.

At the same time, we also must ask for your help in contacting legislators to request that the entire Heritage
Preservation Fund proposal be included



in the 2017-19 Washington State Budget. The Woodland Theatre Repair and Restoration request for 2018 includes replacing the last deteriorating stucco on the back side of the building and enclosing soffits, gable ends and the back porch to preserve our building. This request is near the end of a prioritized list of requests, and it is critical that the entire proposed budget be funded. The Woodland request is the only one from the NE WA region of the state.
