



Fresh off Broadway, Woodland is proud to be selected to be the first theatre in Washington State to be granted the rights to this fantastic show. The story begins with a simple child's wish, "read me a story". From that innocent beginning, Cinderella must navigate this tale of self-discovery, betrayal, growth, friendship, and love on her journey of awakening. This is a jukebox musical based on the songs popularized by Britney Spears. With such incredible production numbers as: Hit Me Baby One More Time, Circus, Womanizer, Toxic, & many more.

(If you cannot make the audition date please contact her) What to prepare for: If you are auditioning, you will be asked to sing from the selections attached to this for the character you are interested in, or chorus. Please review the video and know the songs before auditions! If you need to hear the song to learn it, the easiest way is to watch the video "Once Upon a Time slime tutorial" on you tube. Note about our version – we are allowed to make a few changes in the script. The relationships between characters are more G-rated than in the video. The time markers for the songs are also noted below and on the music sheets attached. A pianist will be provided. In addition, you will be asked to do cold readings in small groups from the script. All those auditioning will learn a short dance number. Please wear appropriate shoes for the dancing. Bring all known rehearsal conflicts for January-March. You may want to bring a sack lunch. Cast Roles: (You don't have to BE these ages, only be able to look and ACT these ages)

<u>Cinderella</u> – Age to appear 16-35. The leading Lady of the fairy kingdom. She & Charming have a romantic relationship, expect physical touching. Vocal range top E5, bottom E3

<u>Snow White</u> – Age to appear 16–35. Pure, innocent, misses most jokes. Cinderella's best friend. Vocal range Top D5, bottom F3. Female

<u>Prince Charming</u> – Age to appear 16-35 A dashing prince who is used to getting what he wants. He & Cinderella have a romantic relationship, expect physical touching. Vocal range Top B4, bottom Bb2. Male <u>Fairy Godmother (OFG)</u> – Age to appear 30-60 A rogue fairy godmother, delightfully daffy. Female <u>Stepmother</u> – Age to appear 40-60. Cinderella's stepmother. A scheming woman who knows how to work a system to get what she wants. Vocal range Range top Bb5, bottom E3. Female

<u>Belinda</u> – Age to appear 14-20. One of Cinderella's Stepsisters. Vocal range top F5 to bottom G3. Female

Betany – Age to appear 14-20. One of Cinderella's Stepsisters. Vocal Range top Eb5 to bottom G3. Female

Rapunzel – Age to appear 16-35 Vocal Range top. Vocal Range top Eb5 to Ab3 Female

<u>Sleeping Beauty</u> – Age to appear 16-35. Vocal range top D#5 to bottom G3. Female

<u>Princess and the Pea</u> – Age to appear 16-35. Vocal range top D5 to bottom F3. Female

<u>Little Mermaid</u> – Age to appear 16-35. Vocal range top Eb5 to bottom Ab3. Female

<u>Clumsy</u> – Age to appear 16-40. Vocal range top B4 to bottom G3. Male (Expect to act like you are attracted to males)

Narrator - Age to appear 25-60. A stern boss who just wants things to run smoothly. Male

Prince Erudite – Age to appear 16-40. Male (Expect to act like you are attracted to males)

Chorus: Ages to appear 16-45. Male & Female

Child - Age to look and act 5-9 years old. Child's parent must also be cast in show or crew. Female

CAPITAL CAMPAIGN Phase Two saw the transformation of a 1950's apartment into a backstage level with our performance space thanks to the amazing generosity of the community in both funds and volunteer efforts. The Covid pause in performances allowed us to complete the new backstage because there was nothing to interrupt and our performers had time on their hands to put into the demolition of the old and finish work on the new.

Now we are ready for the **Preservation and Enhancement of the 1940's original Woodland Theatre**, as our **Phase Three CAPITAL CAMPAIGN.** Thanks to a \$10,000 grant from the INNOVIA foundation, the bowing walls of our auditorium will be strengthened with 7 rods to replace the three cables in preparation for a new, heavier, up-to-code roof planned for 2026-2027 with help from State funds. The historic look of the theatre will be enhanced with an LED lighted tower reminiscent of the one on the original 1940's movie theatre. Eden and Jim Davidson have pledged \$10,00 toward the tower, fully half the expected cost. Investments in new LED stage lighting upgrades will begin this year for improved flexibility, increased safety and lower power bills.


