CAPITAL CAMPAIGN PHASE THREE—2025 to 2029 - Earlier this year rods were installed by Foust Fabrication to stabilize the bowing auditorium walls. Our 86-year-old theatre is now ready for a sturdier, heavier roof with full decking, soffits and gable ends, replacing the 50-year-old roof currently protecting the theatre. This spring Baldwin Signs will be installing an historic-looking tower above the front Façade.

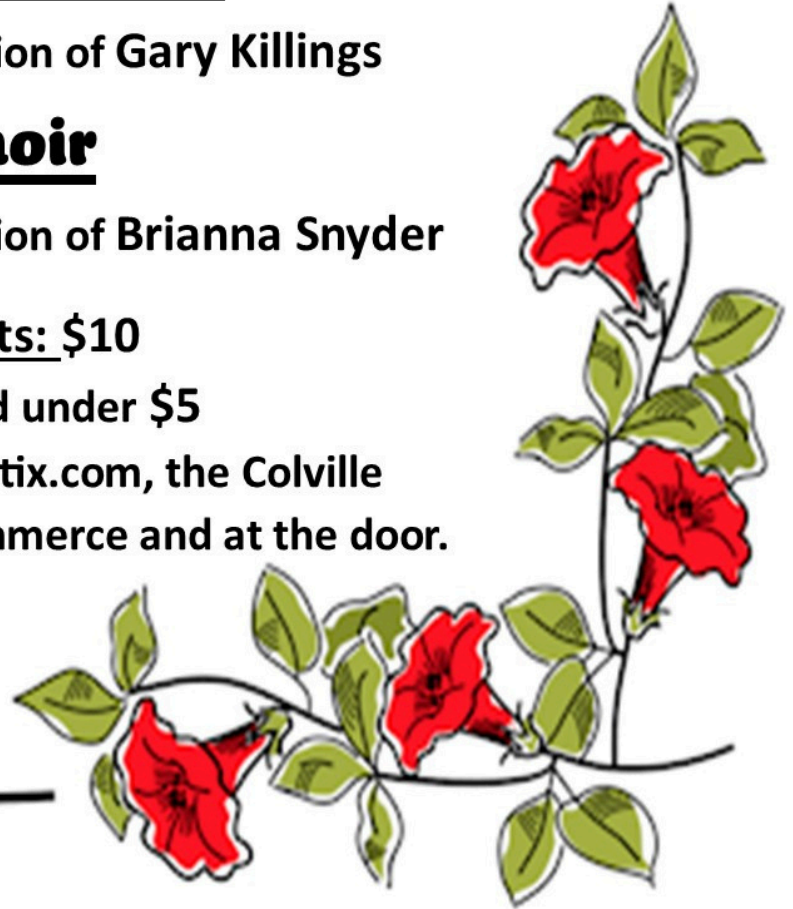

# **Facilities Manager Position at Woodland Productions**

The duties of the facilities employee will be to carry out maintenance and renovation projects for the Woodland Theatre building under the direction of the Facilities Chair and/or the Woodland Board.

## **Duties will include, but are not limited to:**

- Maintain lighting, plumbing, railings, and sidewalk areas for safety with assistance from member volunteers.
- Complete repairs and improvements to Woodland Theatre as time allows
  - Negotiate with contractors, as authorized by the board
    - Oversee work done by local contractors as needed
  - Supervise volunteers on facilities projects and maintenance
  - Report facilities issues that need to be addressed to the Board
- Send a report monthly to the board either in person or through the Facilities Chairperson
- Address urgent issues or arrange for someone close to the theatre to respond as needed

**Hours: 25 hours per month, average for a total of 300 hours per year.**

**Salary: \$30 - \$35/hour or a total of \$9000 to \$10,500 per year.**

**Additional hours may be available for grant and other facilities projects as authorized by the Woodland Board and the Facilities Chairperson.**

**Paid monthly after submission of hours worked and approval by the Facilities Chairperson.**
